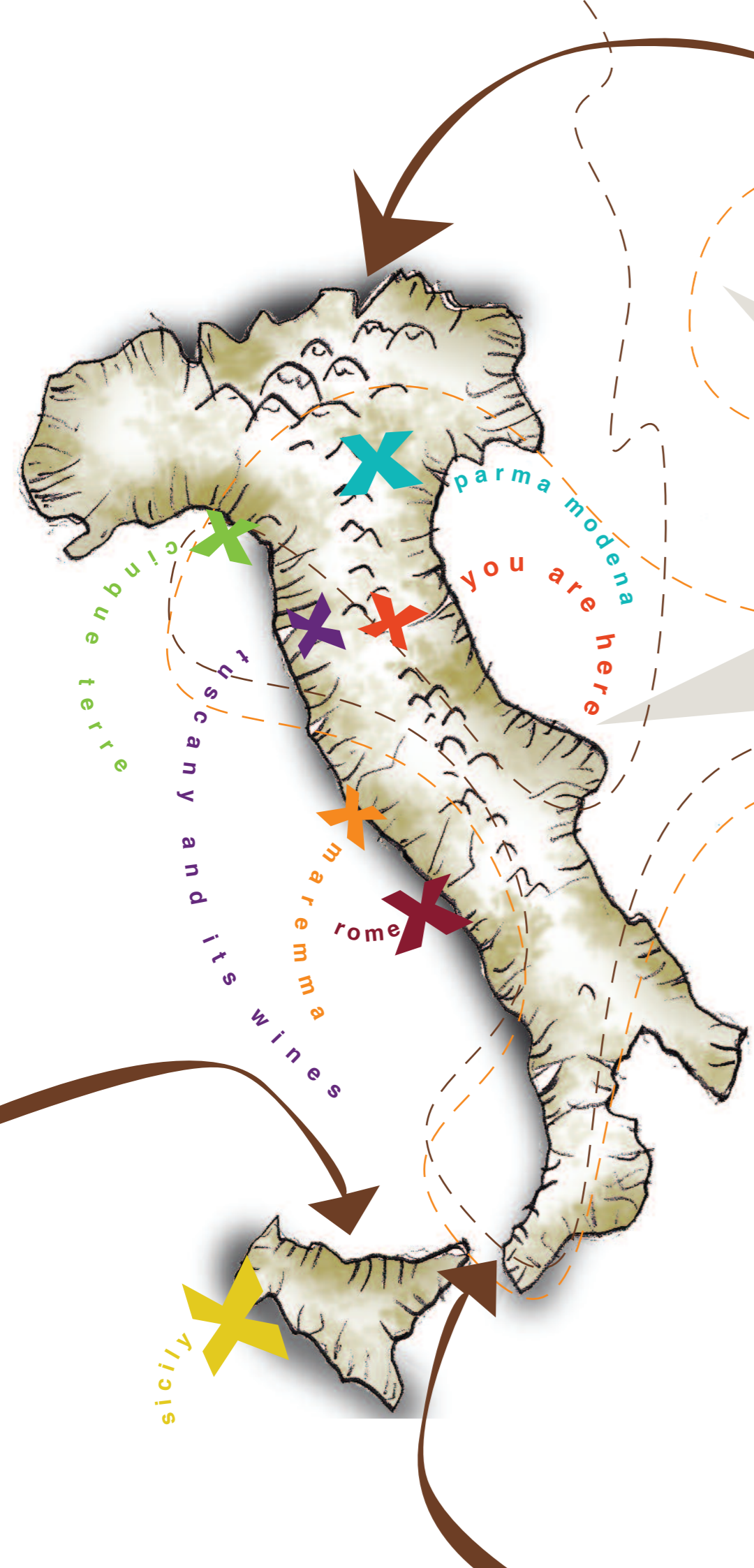
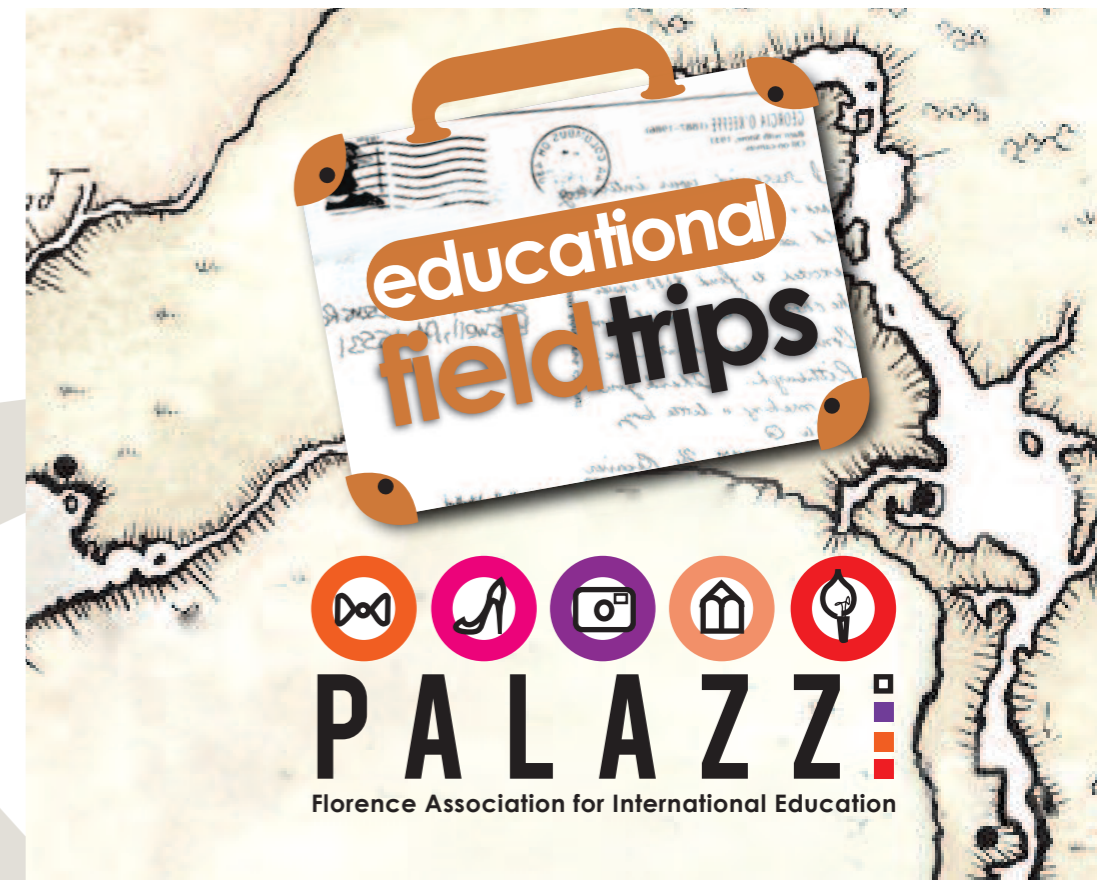

## How to book your spot

In order to guarantee your spot, you must pay a deposit fee when you sign up, then complete your payment by the deadline specified for each excursion.

### Cancellation policy:

In case of cancellation, if the cancellation is communicated to TuscanyAll.com at least 11 days prior to the departure day, the penalty charge will equal 30% of the gross total. ## PARMA/MODENA

May 29th & July 3rd

**Early morning** departure by bus to Parma and visit to a Parmigiano Reggiano cheese factory, where it will be possible to follow all the steps of the production of the cheese, from milk to the finished product. Transfer to Langhirano (Parma) and visit of a Prosciutto di Parma factory. Lunch based on typical products (Parmigiano cheese, prosciutto di Parma, culatello, balsamic vinegar, etc.) Transfer to Modena for a visit to the Acetaia Malpighi to learn about the famous aging process of Aceto Balsamico Tradizionale di Modena. Leave by bus and arrive in Florence around 7:30PM.

**Cost 60 euro**

**The fee includes:** r/t transportation by private bus, visit of the Parmigiano factory + cheese tasting, visit of the Prosciutto factory with tasting lunch, visit of the Balsamic vinegar factory, tour leaders, and insurance.

**The fee does not include:** extra drinks at lunch.

**Payment deadline:** Monday, May 24th & Monday, June 28th

## TUSCANY and ITS WINES

June 26th

**Morning** departure by private bus to Montalcino, visit to the medieval Fortress and tasting of the worldwide famous Brunello, with the aid of a wine expert. Transfer to Montepulciano, the town principally known for the grandeur of its Renaissance palaces, for the elegant beauty of its churches and for Vino Nobile, one of the most appreciated Tuscan wines at an International level. Free time for lunch. Transfer to Gaiole in Chianti and guided tour of the Castello di Brolio, including visit of the castle, cellars and wine tasting. Departure for Florence and arrival around 8:00pm.

**Cost 80 euro**

**The fee includes:** r/t transportation by private bus, entrance to the Fortress in Montalcino + wine tasting, walking tour of Montepulciano, guided tour of the Castello di Brolio (+ cellars and wine tasting), insurance.

**The fee does not include:** lunch in Montepulciano.

**Payment deadline:** Monday, June 21st

## CINQUE TERRE

May 30th & July 31st

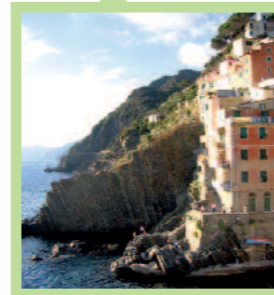
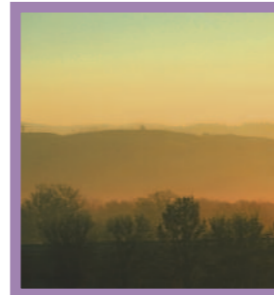
**Morning** departure by bus to La Spezia and transfer by train to Monterosso (Cinque Terre). Hike to Vernazza. Free time for lunch in Vernazza. Transfer by boat to Manarola, then hike to Riomaggiore along the famous *Via dell'Amore*. Departure to Florence and arrival around 7:00pm.

**Cost 50 euro**

**The fee includes:** r/t transportation from Florence by private bus, on-site transportation, hikes in Cinque Terre, tour leaders, insurance.

**The fee does not include:** lunch.

**Payment deadline:** Monday, May 24th & Friday, July 23rd



## SICILY

June 24th – 28th & July 11th - 16th

**Day 1** Departure from Florence by overnight train around 9:00pm (to be confirmed).

**Day 2** Arrive in Taormina early in the morning and visit of the town. A taste of the "authentic" Sicilian cannoli will be included.

Transfer to the beach at Giardini Naxos. Free time for lunch and swimming. Afternoon transfer to Siracusa and hotel check-in:

Jolly Hotel Aretusa Corso Gelone 45 Phone: 0931 461111. Dinner at the hotel.

**Day 3** Visit of the archaeological site (Greek theater, Orecchio di Dionisio, and Catacombs of San Giovanni). Walk to Ortigia (old town) and free time for lunch. Guided walking tour of Ortigia.

Boat tour around Ortigia and swimming. Dinner at the hotel.

**Day 4** Hotel check-out and transfer by bus to Noto. Visit to the famous Baroque town. Transfer to the beach and free time for lunch and swimming. Leave by bus and transfer to Catania to catch the train back to Florence (estimated arrival time in Florence: Mon, at 7:00am).

**Extra costs:** Friday, Saturday and Sunday lunch and drinks.

**Cost 400 euro**

**The fee includes:** r/t transportation by train (beds in sleeping cars), on-site bus transportation, walking tour of Taormina and entrance to the Greek Theater, 2 nights in hotel (double and triple rooms) with breakfast, entrance to the archaeological area in Siracusa, guided tour of Ortigia, boat tour, 2 dinners, tour leaders, insurance.

**The fee does not include:** Fri, Sat and Sun lunch and drinks.

**Payment deadline:** Friday, June 4th & Friday, June 25th

## TUSCAN MAREMMA

June 4th - 6th & July 23rd - 25th

**Friday** Afternoon departure by private bus to Massa Marittima. Arrival and guided visit of the town. Departure to Scansano, hotel check-in and dinner in a typical restaurant.

**Saturday** Guided tour of the tufa stone villages of Sovana and Pitigliano (with their Etruscan Necropolis). Free time for lunch. Transfer to Saturnia to relax in the large natural pools of sulphurous water carved in the rocks. Return to the hotel and dinner.

**Sunday** Visit to the Monte Argentario. Transfer to Capalbio, the trendy location for the wealthy lovers of Maremma. Free time for lunch and beach. Visit to the Giardino dei Tarocchi, the esoteric sculpture garden based on tarot cards, designed by Niki de Saint Phalle. Return to Florence at 10:00pm approx.

**Cost 310 euro**

**The fee includes:** r/t transportation by private bus, 2 nights in hotel (double and triple rooms) with breakfast, 2 dinners in a typical restaurant, guided tour of the tufa stone villages, entrance to the archaeological areas and Giardino dei Tarocchi, tour leaders, insurance.

**The fee does not include:** Friday, Saturday and Sunday lunch.

**Payment deadline:** Monday, May 24th & Friday, July 16th

## ROME July 3rd - 4th

**Saturday 3** Morning departure by train. Arrival and hotel check-in.

Guided tour of the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel, and S. Peter's Basilica. Free time.

Dinner in a typical restaurant.

**Sunday 4** Walking tour of Ancient and Baroque Rome: Colosseo, Foro, Palatino, Pantheon, Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain, Spanish Steps.

Departure by train and arrival in Florence at 8.30pm.

**Cost 250 euro**

**The fee includes:** r/t transportation from Florence by train, walking tours, entrance to the Colosseum, Foro and Palatino, dinner, 1 night in hotel with breakfast, guided tour of the Vatican Museum and entrance ticket.

**The fee does not include:** Saturday & Sunday lunch, extra drinks.

**Payment deadline:** Friday, June 18th
